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### **Environmental Quality Fire in Apex Assessment Report**

**1. Division/Agency Name: DENR (includes Division of Waste Management, Water Quality and Air Quality).**

**2. Current Situation:**

**Division of Waste Management**

- All power washing took place on-site on Wednesday, Oct. 25.
- No on-site activity was allowed on Thursday, Oct. 26 following a court order. Staff members with Division of Waste Management are on-site.
- Soil samples taken off-site were sent to the laboratory for testing on Wednesday, Oct. 25.

**Division of Air Quality**

- All three temporary air-monitoring sites near EQ have power and should be up-and-running by this afternoon at the latest. Sites 1 and 2 are fully operational and should have power for site 3 to be running by 5 p.m.
- Samples are to be analyzed for: particulate matter, mercury, carbonyls (aldehydes like formaldehyde), and VOCs, which we will be able to individually identify.

**Division of Water Quality**

- Staff are conducting physical readings and pulling samples for metals testing upstream and downstream of the EQ site.

**3. Departmental Operational Priorities:**

To monitor on-site cleanup operations as allowed and conduct thorough sampling of air, soil and water quality at and near the EQ site and take samples to laboratories for testing and analysis. The main tasks to be completed include categorizing all materials and determining where it will go and how it will be treated.
