North Carolina Quota Monitored Species Reporting

Species currently under a quota monitoring requirement by the North Carolina Division of Marine Fisheries (NCDMF) include Summer Flounder, Striped Bass, Black Sea Bass North of Cape Hatteras, and Spiny Dogfish. Seasons are opened and closed by proclamation as shown in the table below. Landings reports are updated weekly during the proclamation season.
