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The Solid Waste Section has prepared draft Solid Waste Permit Number 40-02 allowing the Greene County Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill (C&DLF) to continue operations of Phases 1 & 2 pursuant to the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B .0547(4). The C&DLF owned and operated by Greene County is located on 105 Landfill Road in Walstonburg, NC 27888 and encompasses approximately 13-acre waste footprints. The C&DLF is seated on top of the closed 13-acre Municipal Solid Waste Landfill (MSWLF) and has a gross capacity for waste disposal of 434,135 cubic yards. The draft permit also includes conditions for operating miscellaneous waste management units at the facility.

Impact to groundwater from the closed unlined MSWLF requires the implementation of a corrective action plan. An assessment of corrective measures for groundwater treatment was presented at the public meeting held on February 29, 2008. Monitored natural attenuation was the selected remedy. The remedy will combine the existing institutional controls, capping for the source control, and a gas venting system to control decomposition gases. The draft permit contains conditions for the implementation, operation, and assessment of the corrective action plan.

North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules require that the general public be given a 45-day period to comment on this draft permit. The comment period will begin on February 11, 2012, and end at 5:00 PM on March 26, 2012. Comments should be submitted in writing to Ming-Tai Chao, division contact, at the address listed above. All data submitted by the applicant is available as part of the administrative record and may be reviewed during business hours (9 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday-Friday, by appointment) at the Division of Waste Management, 217 West Jones Street, Raleigh, North Carolina.

A public hearing has not been scheduled for this draft permit. Any person interested in a public hearing on this draft permit should notify the division contact. If sufficient interest exists, then a public hearing will be scheduled.
